Green Mystery

Why are the greens so slow? The answer isn't simple, in fact, the reason is much like the season where it's constantly changing. Prior to aerifying we need the greens to be as healthy as possible. Therefore, fertilizer is applied and the greens "pop". After aerifying, we sweeten the soil to activate the fertilizer again, and when the weather cooperates, then the greens, again, "pop".

Players in the afternoon will notice slower greens because the grass is always growing better in the late morning sun. When the warm rains come the grass gets very happy and continues to reach for the sky. During this active season we mow the greens every day. We've also been utilizing our greens roller to help flatten out the grain. If you ever wonder what's happening—the "WHY" - don't hesitate to check with Gary. He's the grass guru and is on top of everything happening on the course!


like it was made to have that add-on!
